

How to Make a DIY Violin Music Cut Out with Strings and a Bow for a Party Centerpiece Decoration

Hi, I'm Ely of A-BnC Parties and More. Welcome to our series of do it yourself centerpiece videos. Today, Judy will show you how to make this violin music cut out centerpiece with strings and a bow.

For this DIY violin music centerpiece you will need:

- #1. A polystyrene violin cut out,
- #2. Some white yarn,
- #3. A tail piece cut from black heavy stock paper,
- #4. Paint to make the F holes (Pattern shown here),
- #5. Fishing line for hair for your bow,
- #6. Wooden dowel for the bow stick and frog,
- #7. Eight clear push pins for the tuning pegs and fine tuners,
- #8. Four straight pins, and a
- #9. "Just Add Sand" centerpiece base.

You also need to furnish some basic tools:

- ✓ a scissors,
- ✓ coping saw,
- ✓ low temperature glue gun and glue.
- ✓ sealer
- ✓ and paints, one for the violin and one for the F holes.

To make a bow, first paint your dowel and let dry. Cut two pieces off the ends dowel for the frogs. Glue the frogs at the ends of the dowel. Then glue fishing line to both frogs and trim.

We seal the violin cutout before we begin. This allows the paint to adhere better. We painted the violin brown to replicate an actual violin color.

We next detail the F Holes with paint. We made a pattern to get the results when making several centerpieces. Let dry before proceeding.

In the next step Judy glues the tail piece to the violin. She presses it flat and lets dry.

Next Judy glues the end of the yarn (still in a ball) onto the neck of the violin. She glues a straight pin into the yarn to hold in place.

She pulls the yarn across the fingerboard to the tail piece. She glues it down and glues in a push pin. Then she trims the yarn.

She repeats this for the other three yarn strings until the violin music cut out with strings is complete.

Push pins are then glued on the sides of the neck where the tuning pegs would be.

Judy takes a pencil and makes a hole in the bottom of the violin for placement. Glue the violin cutout onto one of our "Just Add Sand" Centerpiece bases. Glue the bow onto the violin. Accent with two pieces of onion grass.

Balloons, table names and place cards can be added for a complete budget violin music cutout with strings and bow centerpiece for your Bar mitzvah, Bat mitzvah, theme wedding, or other party or event.
